A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to perpetual care trust funds and a master trust account.
3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

4 SECTION 1. Section 712.021(g), Health and Safety Code, as 5 amended by Chapters 71 (S.B. 1402) and 1051 (H.B. 1948), Acts of the 6 85th Legislature, Regular Session, 2017, is reenacted to read as 7 follows:

(g) In this subsection, "master trust account" means an 8 account containing the perpetual care trust funds of two or more 9 certificate holders for the purpose of collective investment and 10 administration. The trustors of two or more perpetual care trust 11 12 funds may establish a master trust account in which deposits required by this chapter are made, provided that separate records 13 14 of principal and income are maintained for each perpetual care cemetery for the benefit of which the master trust account is 15 established, and further provided that the income attributable to 16 each perpetual care cemetery is used only for the perpetual care of 17 that cemetery. 18
