- 2 relating to perpetual care trust funds and a master trust account.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 712.021(g), Health and Safety Code, as
- 5 amended by Chapters 71 (S.B. 1402) and 1051 (H.B. 1948), Acts of the
- 6 85th Legislature, Regular Session, 2017, is reenacted to read as
- 7 follows:
- 8 (g) In this subsection, "master trust account" means an
- 9 account containing the perpetual care trust funds of two or more
- 10 certificate holders for the purpose of collective investment and
- 11 administration. The trustors of two or more perpetual care trust
- 12 funds may establish a master trust account in which deposits
- 13 required by this chapter are made, provided that separate records
- 14 of principal and income are maintained for each perpetual care
- 15 cemetery for the benefit of which the master trust account is
- 16 established, and further provided that the income attributable to
- 17 each perpetual care cemetery is used only for the perpetual care of
- 18 that cemetery.
- 19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
