- 6 SECTION 1. Article 42A.751, Code of Criminal Procedure, is 7 amended by adding Subsection (b-1) to read as follows:
- 8 (b-1) Notwithstanding Subsection (b), the judge may not
 9 issue a warrant for a violation of a condition of community
 10 supervision solely because the results of a drug test taken by the
 11 defendant indicated that tetrahydrocannabinol or cannabidiol was
 12 present in the body of the defendant.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
