Subchapter C, Chapter 39, Education Code, is 6 amended by adding Section 39.059 to read as follows: 7 Sec. 39.059. DATA TRANSPARENCY. (a) In this section: 8 (1) "Coordinating board" means the Texas Higher 9 Education Coordinating Board. 10 11 (2) "Institution of higher education" has the meaning 12 assigned by Section 61.003. 13 (b) Before the initial release of academic accountability 14 ratings for a school year, the coordinating board shall provide to each school district a copy of all source data as submitted to the 15 16 coordinating board by an institution of higher education that the coordinating board provides to the agency to consider in: 17 18 (1) determining the district's accreditation status under Section 39.052; or 19 (2) assigning performance ratings for the district or 20 21 the district's campuses under Section 39.054.

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
