A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to requiring the provision of instruction to public school
- 3 students subject to in-school or out-of-school suspension.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 37.005, Education Code, is amended by
- 6 adding Subsection (e) to read as follows:
- 7 (e) A school district shall provide to a student during the
- 8 period of the student's suspension under this section, regardless
- 9 of whether the student is placed in in-school or out-of-school
- 10 suspension, an alternative means of receiving all instruction
- 11 provided in the classes the student misses as a result of the
- 12 <u>suspension</u>. The district must provide at least one option for
- 13 receiving the instruction that does not require the use of the
- 14 Internet.
- SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2019-2020
- 16 school year.
- 17 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 18 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 19 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 20 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 21 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
