A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to requirements for student identification cards issued by
3	public institutions of higher education.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter E, Chapter 51, Education Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 51.2095 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 51.2095. STUDENT IDENTIFICATION CARD REQUIREMENTS.
8	(a) In this section "institution of higher education" has the
9	meaning assigned by Section 61.003.
10	(b) The Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board shall
11	develop standards governing the form and appearance of a student
12	identification card issued by an institution of higher education to
13	prevent counterfeiting and ensure that all institutions of higher
14	education issue identification cards in the same form except for
15	features that distinguish each institution. Each institution of
16	higher education must conform to the standards in issuing student
17	identification cards.
18	(c) The standards must require a student identification
19	<pre>card to include:</pre>
20	(1) a distinguishing number assigned by the
21	institution of higher education;
22	(2) a photograph of the entire face of the student;
23	(3) the full name and date of birth of the student;
24	(4) a brief description of the student;

- 1 (5) the student's residence address or, for a student
- 2 using the procedure under Subsection (e), the street address of the
- 3 courthouse in which the student or student's spouse serves as a
- 4 federal judge or state judge; and
- 5 <u>(6) an expiration date.</u>
- 6 (d) A student identification card must include a facsimile
- 7 of the student's signature or a space on which the student shall
- 8 write the student's usual signature in ink immediately on receipt
- 9 of the identification card.
- 10 (e) The governing board of an institution of higher
- 11 education shall establish a procedure, on a student's or a student's
- 12 spouse's qualification for office as a federal judge or a state
- 13 judge as defined by Section 572.002, Government Code, to omit the
- 14 residence address of the judge and the spouse of the judge on the
- 15 student's student identification card and to include, in lieu of
- 16 that address, the street address of the courthouse in which the
- 17 student or student's spouse serves as a federal judge or state
- 18 judge.
- 19 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies
- 20 beginning with student identification cards issued by public
- 21 institutions of higher education for the 2020-2021 academic year.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 25 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 26 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
