12	SECTION 3. Subchapter B, Chapter 28A, Water Code, is
13	amended by adding Section 28A.055 to read as follows:
14	Sec. 28A.055. LOCATION OF AGGREGATE PRODUCTION OPERATIONS
15	IN CERTAIN COUNTIES. (a) This section applies only to a county:
16	(1) that is adjacent to a county with a population of
17	500,000 or more; and
18	(2) that, according to the most recent federal
19	decennial census, had population growth of more than 30 percent
20	during the decade preceding the most recent federal decennial
21	<u>census.</u>
22	(b) The commissioners court of a county by order may
23	regulate the construction of an aggregate production operation by
24	restricting the location of a production operation to not less than

1 one mile from a residence, school, place of worship, or hospital.

SECTION 4. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to an aggregate production operation the construction of which begins on or after the effective date of this Act. An aggregate production operation that was constructed before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect immediately before the effective date of this Act, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.

SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
