

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the provision of solid waste disposal services in the
3 extraterritorial jurisdiction of certain municipalities.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 364, Health and Safety
6 Code, is amended by adding Section 364.0341 to read as follows:

7 Sec. 364.0341. SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL SERVICES IN
8 EXTRATERRITORIAL JURISDICTION OF CERTAIN MUNICIPALITIES. (a) This
9 section applies only to a municipality wholly or partly located in a
10 county with a population of more than 54,000 and less than 54,500.

11 (b) Notwithstanding Sections 364.011(a) and 364.034(a), a
12 county may offer, require the use of, and charge a fee for solid
13 waste disposal services in the extraterritorial jurisdiction of a
14 municipality.

15 (c) A municipality may not provide solid waste disposal
16 services or charge a fee for those services in the municipality's
17 extraterritorial jurisdiction if the county provides those
18 services under Subsection (b).

19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
