- SECTION 1. Section 39A.112, Education Code, is amended by 7
- amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsections (b-1) and (b-2) to 8

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- Notwithstanding Section 39A.101, if a campus has been 10
- assigned an unacceptable performance rating under Section 39.054 11
- 12 for two consecutive school years, a majority of the parents of the
- students enrolled at the campus may, at any time, submit a petition 13
- 14 to the commissioner requesting that the commissioner order one of
- the following actions: 15
- 16 (1) appointment of a board of managers to govern the
- school district as provided by Section 39A.202; 17

- 3 (b-1) The commissioner shall consider the action requested
- 4 in a parents' petition under Subsection (b) in determining whether
- 5 to order the requested action or another permissible action under

- 7 <u>implement a campus turnaround plan.</u>
- 8 (b-2) A petition submitted under Subsection (b) must be in a
- 9 form prescribed by the commissioner.
- SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2019-2020
- 11 school year.
- 12 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 13 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 14 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 15 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 16 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
