- 8 Sec. 142.0095. INVESTIGATIONS OF HOME AND COMMUNITY SUPPORT
- 9 SERVICES AGENCIES PROVIDING HOSPICE SERVICES. The commission or
- 10 <u>its authorized representative shall investigate an allegation of</u>
- 11 abuse, neglect, or exploitation of a client of any age of a home and
- 12 <u>community support services agency if:</u>
- 13 (1) the abuse, neglect, or exploitation occurs when
- 14 the client is receiving inpatient hospice services; and
- 15 (2) the alleged perpetrator of the abuse, neglect, or
- 16 exploitation is an employee, volunteer, contractor, or
- 17 subcontractor of the home and community support services agency.
- 18 SECTION 2. Section 142.0095, Health and Safety Code, as
- 19 added by this Act, applies only to an allegation made on or after
- 20 the effective date of this Act.
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 24 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
