- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 7 SECTION 1. Section 552.138, Government Code, is amended by
- 8 amending Subsections (b) and (c) and adding Subsection (b-1) to
- 9 read as follows:
- 10 (b) Information maintained by a family violence shelter
- 11 center, victims of trafficking shelter center, or sexual assault
- 12 program is excepted from the requirements of Section 552.021 if it
- 13 is information that relates to:
- 14 (1) the home address, home telephone number, or social
- 15 security number of an employee or a volunteer worker of a family
- 16 violence shelter center, victims of trafficking shelter center, or
- 17 sexual assault program, regardless of whether the employee or
- 18 worker complies with Section 552.024;
- 19 (2) [the location or physical layout of a family
- 20 violence shelter center or victims of trafficking shelter center;
- [$\frac{(3)}{(3)}$] the name, home address, home telephone number,
- 22 or numeric identifier of a current or former client of a family
- 23 violence shelter center, victims of trafficking shelter center, or
- 24 sexual assault program;

- 1 (3) $\left[\frac{4}{1}\right]$ the provision of services, including
- 2 counseling and sheltering, to a current or former client of a family
- 3 violence shelter center, victims of trafficking shelter center, or
- 4 sexual assault program;
- 5 (4) $\left[\frac{(5)}{(5)}\right]$ the name, home address, or home telephone
- 6 number of a private donor to a family violence shelter center,
- 7 victims of trafficking shelter center, or sexual assault program;
- 8 or
- 9 (5) $[\frac{(6)}{(6)}]$ the home address or home telephone number of
- 10 a member of the board of directors or the board of trustees of a
- 11 family violence shelter center, victims of trafficking shelter
- 12 center, or sexual assault program, regardless of whether the board
- 13 member complies with Section 552.024.
- 14 (b-1) Information that relates to the location or physical
- 15 layout of a family violence shelter center or victims of
- 16 trafficking shelter center is confidential.
- 17 (c) A governmental body may redact information maintained
- 18 by a family violence shelter center, victims of trafficking shelter
- 19 center, or sexual assault program that may be withheld under
- 20 Subsection (b)(1) or (5) or that is confidential under Subsection
- 21 $\underline{(b-1)}$ [$\underline{(6)}$] from any information the governmental body discloses
- 22 under Section 552.021 without the necessity of requesting a
- 23 decision from the attorney general under Subchapter G.
- 24 SECTION 2. Chapter 42, Penal Code, is amended by adding
- 25 Section 42.075 to read as follows:
- Sec. 42.075. DISCLOSURE OF CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION
- 27 REGARDING FAMILY VIOLENCE OR VICTIMS OF TRAFFICKING SHELTER CENTER.

- 1 (a) In this section, "family violence shelter center" and "victims
- 2 of trafficking shelter center" have the meanings assigned by
- 3 <u>Section 552.138</u>, Government Code.
- 4 (b) A person commits an offense if the person, with the
- 5 intent to threaten the safety of any inhabitant of a family violence
- 6 <u>shelter center or victims of trafficking shelter center, discloses</u>
- 7 or publicizes the location or physical layout of the center.
- 8 (c) An offense under this section is a Class A misdemeanor.
- 9 (d) If conduct constituting an offense under this section
- 10 also constitutes an offense under Section 552.352, Government Code,
- 11 the actor may be prosecuted under either section.
- 12 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 13 to a request for public information received on or after the
- 14 effective date of this Act. A request received before the effective
- 15 date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the
- 16 request was received, and the former law is continued in effect for
- 17 that purpose.
- 18 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
