Section 43.24(c), Penal Code, is repealed. 17 18 SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act. An 19 offense committed before the effective date of this Act is governed 20 by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed, and the 21 former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of 22 23 this section, an offense was committed before the effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred before that date. 24
