SECTION 1. Section 469.052, Government Code, is amended by adding Subsection (b-1) to read as follows:

______t<u>o___</u> (b−1) Subject Subsection (b) the standards specifications adopted by the commission under this chapter must provide that:

if accessible <u>provid</u>ed an parking space accordance with a requirement of the standards and specifications is paved:

> (A) the international symbol of access must be

painted on the parking space; and
