- 8 DEGREE PROGRAM. (a) The governing board of the Lone Star College
- 9 System District may establish an occupational and life skills
- 10 associate degree program at each junior college in the district.
- 11 (b) An occupational and life skills associate degree
- 12 program established at a junior college under this section must
- 13 require a student to successfully complete:
- 14 (1) the junior college's core curriculum adopted under
- 15 Section 61.822(b); and
- 16 (2) after completion of the core curriculum under
- 17 Subdivision (1), the courses selected by the student in the
- 18 student's degree plan.
- 19 (c) The coordinating board shall adopt rules as necessary
- 20 for the administration of this section.
- 21 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
