1-19 relating to the confidentiality of certain personal information of
 1-20 an applicant for disaster recovery funds.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 552, Government Code, is
 1-23 amended by adding Section 552.160 to read as follows:

1-24 Sec. 552.160. CONFIDENTIALITY OF PERSONAL INFORMATION OF
 1-25 APPLICANT FOR DISASTER RECOVERY FUNDS. (a) In this section,
 1-26 "disaster" has the meaning assigned by Section 418.004.

1-27 (b) Except as provided by Subsection (c), the following
 1-28 information maintained by a governmental body is confidential:

1-29 (1) the name, social security number, house number,
 1-30 street name, and telephone number of an individual or household
 1-31 that applies for state or federal disaster recovery funds;

1-32 (2) the name, tax identification number, address, and
 1-33 telephone number of a business entity or an owner of a business
 1-34 entity that applies for state or federal disaster recovery funds;
 1-35 and

1-36 (3) any other information the disclosure of which
 1-37 would identify or tend to identify a person or household that
 1-38 applies for state or federal disaster recovery funds.

1-39 (c) The street name and census block group of and the amount
 1-40 of disaster recovery funds awarded to a person or household are not
 1-41 confidential after the date on which disaster recovery funds are
 1-42 awarded to the person or household.

1-43 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
