- 2 relating to standards for expulsion policies of certain child-care
- 3 facilities.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 42, Human Resources Code,
- 6 is amended by adding Section 42.0429 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 42.0429. POLICY ON EXPULSION. (a) Each day-care
- 8 center, group day-care home, and listed or registered family home
- 9 shall review the facility's policies to determine whether the
- 10 <u>facility</u> has adopted a policy that addresses procedures for
- 11 suspending or expelling a child from the facility.
- 12 (b) If a facility described by Subsection (a) has not
- 13 adopted an expulsion policy, the facility shall consider adopting a
- 14 policy that describes the procedures the facility must follow
- 15 before the facility may suspend or expel a child from the facility
- 16 and that includes:
- 17 (1) the procedures facility teachers and other
- 18 personnel must follow when providing care to a child with
- 19 behavioral issues;
- 20 (2) the communications facility personnel must have
- 21 with the child's family and caregivers; and
- 22 (3) any referrals facility personnel may make to
- 23 behavioral health specialists who may be available to address the
- 24 <u>child's behavioral issues.</u>
