- SECTION 3. Section 55.007(b), Transportation Code, 25 is 26 repealed.
- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 27

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- 1 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 2 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 3 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 4 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
