H.B. No. 3216

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to 72-hour and 144-hour registration permits for
3 commercial motor vehicles, trailers, semitrailers, and motor
4 buses.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Section 502.094, Transportation Code, is amended
7 by adding Subsection (i) to read as follows:

8 (i) A receipt for a temporary registration permit issued
9 under this section shall be carried in the vehicle at all times
10 during the period for which the permit is valid. The temporary tag
11 must contain all pertinent information required by this section and
12 must be displayed in the rear window of the vehicle so that the tag
13 is clearly visible and legible when viewed from the rear of the
14 vehicle. If the vehicle does not have a rear window, the temporary
15 tag must be attached to or carried in the vehicle to allow ready
16 inspection.

17 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
