- 2 relating to the discipline and behavior management of a public

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 37.0012, Education Code, is amended by
- 6 adding Subsection (g) to read as follows:
- 7 (g) If a student violates the student code of conduct
- 8 adopted under Section 37.001, the campus behavior coordinator may:
- 9 (1) create a behavior contract for the student stating
- 10 that appropriate disciplinary action may be taken against the
- 11 student as provided by the student code of conduct if the student
- 12 continues to engage in the violative behavior; and
- 13 (2) require the student and the student's parent or
- 14 guardian to sign the contract as a condition of not taking immediate
- 15 disciplinary action against the student.
- SECTION 2. Section 37.008(a), Education Code, is amended to
- 17 read as follows:
- 18 (a) Each school district shall provide a disciplinary
- 19 alternative education program that:
- 20 (1) is provided in a setting other than a student's
- 21 regular classroom;
- 22 (2) is located on or off of a regular school campus;
- 23 (3) provides for the students who are assigned to the
- 24 disciplinary alternative education program to be separated from

- 1 students who are not assigned to the program;
- 2 (4) focuses on English language arts, mathematics,
- 3 science, history, and self-discipline;
- 4 (5) provides for students' educational and behavioral
- 5 needs, including by administering relevant behavioral assessments;
- 6 (6) provides supervision and counseling; and
- 7 (7) employs only teachers who meet all certification
- 8 requirements established under Subchapter B, Chapter 21.
- 9 SECTION 3. This Act applies beginning with the 2019-2020
- 10 school year.
- 11 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 12 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 13 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 14 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 15 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
