9	claims administrator, if the provider is:
10	(1) credentialed by a managed care organization that
11	contracts with the commission under Chapter 533; or
12	(2) enrolled as a Medicare provider.
13	(f) The commission shall track the number of providers that
14	enroll as Medicaid providers through each type of enrollment
15	process described by Subsection (e), including the enrollment
16	process through the entity serving as the state's Medicaid claims
17	administrator.
18	(g) The commission shall develop a process to streamline the
19	Medicaid enrollment of a provider who:
20	(1) provides services to a recipient who is also
21	enrolled in a private group health benefit plan; and

SECTION 2. If before implementing any provision of this Act
