4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 21.451(d), Education Code, is amended to
6	read as follows:
7	(d) The staff development:
8	(1) may include training in:
9	(A) technology;
10	(B) conflict resolution;
11	(C) discipline strategies, including classroom
12	management, district discipline policies, and the student code of
13	conduct adopted under Section 37.001 and Chapter 37;
14	(D) preventing, identifying, responding to, and
15	reporting incidents of bullying; and
16	(E) digital learning;
17	(2) subject to Subsection (e) and to Section 21.3541
18	and rules adopted under that section, must include training that is
19	evidence-based, as defined by Section 8101, Every Student Succeeds
20	Act (20 U.S.C. Section 7801), that:
21	(A) relates to instruction of students with
22	disabilities; and
23	(B) is designed for educators who work primarily
24	outside the area of special education; and

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- 1 (3) must include suicide prevention training that must
- 2 be provided:
- 3 (A) on an annual basis, as part of a new employee
- 4 orientation, to all new school district and open-enrollment charter
- 5 school educators; and
- 6 (B) to existing school district and
- 7 open-enrollment charter school educators on a schedule adopted by
- 8 the agency by rule that requires an educator to be trained at least
- 9 once every two years.
- 10 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
