- 4 SECTION 1. Sections 172.1111(a) and (c), Election Code, are
- 5 amended to read as follows:
- 6 (a) Before the opening of the polls <u>during the early voting</u>
 7 <u>period and on election day</u>, the presiding judge shall post at each
 8 outside door through which a voter may enter the building in which
 9 the polling place is located a written notice in bold print of the
 10 date, hour, and place for each precinct, county, senatorial, or
 11 state convention that a voter in the precinct may be eligible to
- 12 attend during the election year.
 13 (c) The notice must remain posted conti
- 13 (c) The notice must remain posted continuously through <u>the</u>
 14 <u>early voting period and on</u> election day.
- SECTION 2. Section 172.1112(a), Election Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 17 (a) The county clerk shall post a notice of the election and
- 18 a notice of consolidated precincts, if applicable, in the manner
- 19 prescribed by Section 4.003(b) for general and special elections.
- 20 The notice of the election shall be posted on the county clerk's
- 21 [party's] Internet website, if the county clerk [party] maintains a
- 22 website. If the county clerk [party] does not maintain a website,
- 23 the notice shall be posted on the bulletin board used for posting
- 24 notice of meetings of the commissioners court.

1 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
