- 10 (1) applicable to a license to carry a handgun under
- 11 Subchapter H, other than requirements regarding evidence of handgun
- 12 proficiency; or
- (2) established by the department under Subsection
- 14 (d).
- 15 (d) For a person who does not meet the eligibility
- 16 requirements under Subsection (b)(1) on account of a disqualifying
- 17 criminal conviction, the department shall establish eligibility
- 18 requirements for a Capitol access pass that include taking into
- 19 account:
- 20 (1) the amount of time that has passed following the
- 21 <u>criminal conviction; and</u>
- 22 (2) evidence of good standing in the community
