H.B. No. 3266

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to fees charged to students enrolled at component 3 institutions of The Texas A&M University System. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Section 54.5032(a), Education Code, is amended 5 to read as follows: 6 (a) A student fee advisory committee is established at each 7 component institution of The Texas A&M University System to advise 8 the board of regents and the administration of the institution on 9 the type, amount, and expenditure of compulsory fees for student 10 services under Section 54.503, for student [health and] medical 11 12 services under Section 54.507, for student center facilities under Section 54.521, and for recreational sports under Section 54.539. 13 14 SECTION 2. The heading to Section 54.507, Education Code, is amended to read as follows: 15 Sec. 54.507. STUDENT [CROUP HOSPITAL AND] MEDICAL SERVICES 16 FEES; THE TEXAS A&M UNIVERSITY SYSTEM. 17 18 SECTION 3. Sections 54.507(a), (b), (c), and (f), Education Code, are amended to read as follows: 19 The Board of Regents of The Texas A&M University System 20 (a) 21 may levy and collect from each student at any institution of higher education which is a part of The Texas A&M University System a 22 23 compulsory student [group hospital and] medical services fee not to exceed $\frac{200}{5}$ [\$75] for each regular semester and not to exceed $\frac{100}{5}$ 24

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1 [\$25] for each term of each summer session. The compulsory student
2 [group hospital and] medical services fee may not be levied unless
3 the levy of the fee has been approved by a majority vote of those
4 students at the affected institution participating in a general
5 student election called for that purpose.

6 (b) In addition to the fee authorized under Subsection (a) 7 [of this section], the Board of Regents of The Texas A&M University 8 System may levy and collect from each student registered at Prairie View A&M University a supplemental student [group hospital and] 9 10 medical services fee not to exceed \$30 for each regular semester and not to exceed \$12.50 for each term of the summer session. The 11 supplemental student [group hospital and] medical services fee may 12 not be levied unless the levy of the fee has been approved by a 13 14 majority vote of the students registered at Prairie View A&M 15 University participating in a general election called for that 16 purpose.

17 (c) A fee levied under this section at a component 18 institution of The Texas A&M University System may be used only to 19 <u>finance, construct, operate, renovate, maintain, or improve new or</u> 20 <u>existing student medical facilities or provide [hospital or other]</u> 21 medical services to students registered at that component 22 institution.

(f) An election under this section must also permit the students to vote on whether <u>student</u> [hospital and] medical services should be provided to students at the institution by the institution or by a private entity. The vote by the students on the responsibility for provision of <u>student</u> [hospital and] medical

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1 services to students at the institution is not binding on the 2 institution.

3 SECTION 4. Sections 54.521(a) and (e), Education Code, are 4 amended to read as follows:

5 (a) The board of regents of The Texas A&M University System may levy a regular, fixed student fee on each student enrolled in an 6 educational institution within The Texas A&M University System for 7 8 the purpose of acquiring, constructing, renovating, operating, maintaining, improving, adding to, replacing, financing, 9 and 10 equipping one or more student center facilities for the institution. The board may set fees in amounts it considers just and 11 12 necessary but not to exceed \$200 [\$100] per student for each semester for the long session and not to exceed $\frac{100}{50}$ [50] per 13 14 student for each term of the summer session, or any fractional part 15 of a session. The activities of a student center facility that may be financed in whole or in part by the student center facility fee 16 17 are limited to those activities in which the entire student body is eligible to participate. The financed activities may not be held 18 outside the territorial limits of any educational institution 19 within The Texas A&M University System. 20

(e) The <u>amount of the</u> fee authorized by this section may not be increased from one academic year to the next <u>by 10 percent or</u> <u>more</u>, unless the increase has been approved by a majority vote of the students at the affected institution participating in a general election called for that purpose <u>or</u>, <u>if the amount of the fee</u> <u>increase does not exceed 10 percent</u>, the amount of the fee increase has been approved by a majority vote of the board of regents taken

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1 <u>at a board meeting on the increase after giving students an</u> 2 <u>opportunity for public comment on the increase</u> [except that at 3 Tarleton State University the fee may be increased by not more than 4 10 percent from one academic year to the next without holding an 5 election]. The fee may not exceed the maximum amounts provided by 6 Subsection (a).

7 SECTION 5. Sections 54.507 and 54.521, Education Code, as 8 amended by this Act, apply beginning with fees charged for the 9 2019-2020 academic year. A fee charged in an academic year before 10 that academic year is covered by the law in effect before the 11 effective date of this Act, and the former law is continued in 12 effect for that purpose.

13 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 14 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 15 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 16 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 17 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
