- 8 means any conduct that tends to show that a person pursued another,
- 9 including waiting for the person, tracking or trailing the person,
- 10 and maintaining visual contact with the person.
- 11 (b) A person commits an offense if, with the intent to
- 12 commit an offense under Section 29.02, 29.03, 30.04, or 31.03, the
- 13 person:
- 14 (1) follows another person; and
- 15 (2) engages in conduct constituting an offense under
- 16 Section 31.03 against the person followed.
- 17 (c) An offense under this section is a felony of the third
- 18 <u>degree</u>.
- 19 <u>(d) If conduct that constitutes an offense under this</u>
- 20 section also constitutes an offense under other law, the actor may
- 21 be prosecuted under this section, the other law, or both.
- 22 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 23 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.

- 1 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed,
- 2 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For
- 3 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the
- 4 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred
- 5 before that date.
- 6 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
