- 2 [(B) an agreement to defer payment of a debt and

- 4 [(C) any amount received by the buyer in excess
- 5 of the price paid for the property by the buyer is interest subject

- 7 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 8 a sale-leaseback transaction entered into on or after the effective
- 9 date of this Act. A sale-leaseback transaction entered into before
- 10 the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on
- 11 the date the sale-leaseback transaction was entered into, and the
- 12 former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
