 1-20 AN ACT

1-21 relating to the sunset review of the Texas Health Services
 1-22 Authority and the repeal of certain provisions affecting the
 1-23 electronic exchange of health information.

1-24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
 1-25 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 182, Health and Safety
 1-26 Code, is amended by adding Section 182.004 to read as follows:
 1-27 Sec. 182.004. APPLICATION OF SUNSET ACT. The Texas Health
 1-28 Services Authority is subject to Chapter 325, Government Code
 1-29 (Texas Sunset Act). Unless continued in existence as provided by
 1-30 that chapter, the corporation is abolished and this section,
 1-31 Section 182.001, and Subchapters B and C expire September 1, 2027.

1-32 SECTION 2. The following provisions of the Health and
 1-33 Safety Code are repealed:
 1-34 (1) Section 182.003;
 1-35 (2) Section 182.052;
 1-36 (3) Section 182.101(b);
 1-37 (4) Section 182.102(c);
 1-38 (5) Section 182.103(d);
 1-39 (6) Section 182.104(b);
 1-40 (7) Section 182.105(b);
 1-41 (8) Section 182.106(b);
 1-42 (9) Section 182.107(d); and
 1-43 (10) Section 182.108(f).

1-44 SECTION 3. Section 15(b), Chapter 12 (S.B. 203), Acts of the
 1-45 84th Legislature, Regular Session, 2015, which added Sections
 1-46 182.108(g), (h), (i), (j), (k), (l), (m), and (n), Health and Safety
 1-47 Code, effective September 1, 2021, is repealed.

1-48 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
