7	Sec. 501.070. ASSISTANCE IN OBTAINING FEDERAL VETERANS
8	DISABILITY BENEFITS. For purposes of assisting an inmate who is a
9	veteran in obtaining federal veterans disability benefits, the
10	department shall ensure that, as soon as practicable after
11	receiving a request from the inmate:
12	(1) an appropriate medical or health care
13	<pre>professional:</pre>
14	(A) assists the inmate in completing a disability
15	benefits questionnaire at the facility in which the inmate is
16	confined or at another appropriate location; or
17	(B) conducts any necessary examination or
18	evaluation of the inmate at the facility in which the inmate is
19	confined or at another appropriate location; and
20	(2) the questionnaire or other documents required for
21	the inmate to receive benefits are submitted to the United States
22	Department of Veterans Affairs or a veterans service organization
23	chartered by the United States Congress or recognized by the United
24	States Department of Veterans Affairs
