C.S.H.B. No. 3322

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to requiring a school district to post on the district's
3 Internet website the contact information of the school
4 administrator primarily responsible for student discipline at a
5 district campus.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

7 SECTION 1. Chapter 26, Education Code, is amended by adding
8 Section 26.015 to read as follows:

9 Sec. 26.015. POSTING OF INFORMATION REGARDING
10 ADMINISTRATOR RESPONSIBLE FOR STUDENT DISCIPLINE. A school
11 district shall post on the district's Internet website, for each
12 district campus, the e-mail address and dedicated telephone number
13 of a person clearly identified as:

14 (1) the campus behavior coordinator designated under
15 Section 37.0012; or

16 (2) if the district has been designated as a district
17 of innovation under Chapter 12A and is exempt from the requirement
18 to designate a campus behavior coordinator under Section 37.0012
19 under the district's local innovation plan, a campus administrator
20 designated as being responsible for student discipline.

21 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2019-2020
22 school year.

23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

1 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
2 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
3 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
