- 7 SECTION 1. Chapter 26, Education Code, is amended by adding
- 8 Section 26.015 to read as follows:
- 9 Sec. 26.015. POSTING OF INFORMATION REGARDING
- 10 ADMINISTRATOR RESPONSIBLE FOR STUDENT DISCIPLINE. A school
- 11 district shall post on the district's Internet website, for each
- 12 district campus, the name and contact information of:
- 13 (1) the campus behavior coordinator designated under
- 14 Section 37.0012; or
- 15 (2) if the district has been designated as a district
- 16 of innovation under Chapter 12A and is exempt from the requirement
- 17 to designate a campus behavior coordinator under Section 37.0012
- 18 under the district's local innovation plan, the school
- 19 administrator primarily responsible for student discipline.
- 20 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2019-2020
- 21 school year.
- 22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

- 1 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 2 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
