4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Chapter 21, Property Code, is amended by adding
6	Subchapter B-1 to read as follows:
7	SUBCHAPTER B-1. ADDITIONAL PROCEDURES FOR ACQUISITION OF CERTAIN
8	PROPERTY BY COMMON CARRIER
9	Sec. 21.031. DEFINITION. In this subchapter, "common
10	carrier" means a common carrier governed by Chapter 111, Natural
11	Resources Code.
12	Sec. 21.032. NOTICE OF INTENT BY COMMON CARRIER. (a) A
13	common carrier that intends to exercise eminent domain authority to
14	acquire real property for the construction and operation of an oil
15	and gas pipeline must send a written notice of intent to:
16	(1) the county judge of:
17	(A) the county in which the proposed pipeline
18	route is located; and
19	(B) each county the territorial boundaries of
20	which are located within five miles of the location of the proposed
21	pipeline route; and
22	(2) if applicable, the board of directors of:
23	(A) any groundwater conservation district
24	governed by Chapter 36, Water Code, in which the proposed pipeline

- 1 route is located; and
- 2 (B) each groundwater conservation district
- 3 governed by Chapter 36, Water Code, the territorial boundaries of
- 4 which are located within five miles of the location of the proposed
- 5 pipeline route.
- 6 (b) A notice sent under Subsection (a) must:
- 7 (1) state the common carrier's intent to acquire real
- 8 property for public use;
- 9 (2) specify that the public use is the construction
- 10 and operation of an oil and gas pipeline;
- 11 (3) identify the real property the common carrier
- 12 intends to acquire and the owners of the property; and
- 13 (4) identify and provide contact information for all
- 14 recipients of the notice.
- 15 Sec. 21.033. PROHIBITED CONTACT BEFORE NOTICE PROVIDED. A
- 16 common carrier may not contact any property owner identified in the
- 17 notice of intent until after the seventh day after the date the
- 18 notice of intent is sent under Section 21.032.
- 19 Sec. 21.034. PUBLIC MEETING. (a) The recipients of a
- 20 notice under Section 21.032 shall confer and, not later than the
- 21 60th day after the date the last recipient receives notice, the
- 22 county judge or judges and board or boards of directors, as
- 23 applicable, may jointly select a date on which a public meeting will
- 24 be held to consider the proposed pipeline route.
- 25 (b) If a public meeting is scheduled under Subsection (a),
- 26 the meeting must take place in a public location appropriate to the
- 27 <u>size</u> and nature of the meeting in a county or county and groundwater

- 1 conservation district, as applicable, through which the proposed
- 2 route will pass.
- 3 Sec. 21.035. NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING. (a) As soon as
- 4 practicable after the date for the public meeting under Section
- 5 21.034 is selected, a county judge or a member of a board of
- 6 directors of a groundwater conservation district jointly
- 7 designated by the notice recipients shall give notice of the
- 8 meeting to the common carrier.
- 9 (b) Not later than the 30th day before the date of the public
- 10 meeting, notice of the public meeting shall be published:
- 11 (1) by each county judge of a county that received
- 12 notice under Section 21.032 on that county's Internet website;
- 13 (2) if applicable, by each board of directors of a
- 14 groundwater conservation district that received notice under
- 15 Section 21.032 on that district's Internet website; and
- 16 (3) in a newspaper of general circulation in each
- 17 county described by Subdivision (1) and, if applicable, in each
- 18 groundwater conservation district described by Subdivision (2).
- 19 (c) A notice of public meeting under this section must
- 20 include the date, time, and location of the meeting.
- 21 Sec. 21.036. PARTICIPATION BY COMMON CARRIER. A
- 22 representative of a common carrier that gives notice of intent
- 23 under Section 21.032 shall attend and participate in any public
- 24 meeting scheduled under Section 21.034.
- Sec. 21.037. OFFERS BY CERTAIN COMMON CARRIERS PROHIBITED.
- 26 A common carrier that does not attend and participate in a public
- 27 meeting as required by Section 21.036 may not make a bona fide offer
