A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to waiver of continuing education requirements for certain
3 insurance adjusters.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 4101.060, Insurance Code, is amended by
6 adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:

7 (d) Notwithstanding Section 4004.051, the department shall
8 waive any continuing education requirement imposed under this
9 chapter or Chapter 4004 for an adjuster who, during the license
10 period for which the continuing education is required, receives a
11 certificate of completion of a continuing education program issued
12 by a professional organization of adjusters if:

13 (1) the number of hours required to complete the
14 continuing education program is not less than the number of hours of
15 continuing education that an adjuster is required to complete
16 during the license period under Sections 4004.053 and 4004.054; and

17 (2) the content of the continuing education program
18 includes the content required under Section 4004.105.

19 SECTION 2. (a) Not later than December 1, 2019, the
20 commissioner of insurance shall adopt the rules necessary to
21 implement Section 4101.060(d), Insurance Code, as added by this
22 Act.

23 (b) The change in law made by Section 4101.060(d), Insurance
24 Code, as added by this Act, applies to continuing education

3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
