## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 1455.001, Insurance Code, is amended by
- 7 adding Subdivision (2-a) to read as follows:
- 8 (2-a) "Platform" means the technology, system,
- 9 software, application, modality, or other method through which a
- 10 health professional remotely interfaces with a patient when
- 11 providing a health care service or procedure as a telemedicine
- 12 medical service or telehealth service.
- SECTION 2. Section 1455.004, Insurance Code, is amended by
- 14 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsections (b-1) and (d) to
- 15 read as follows:
- 16 (a) A health benefit plan:
- 17 (1) must provide coverage for a covered health care
- 18 service or procedure delivered by a preferred or contracted health
- 19 professional to a covered patient as a telemedicine medical service
- 20 or telehealth service on the same basis and to the same extent that
- 21 the plan provides coverage for the service or procedure in an
- 22 <u>in-person setting; and</u>
- 23 (2) may not:
- 24 (A) exclude from coverage a covered health care

- 1 service or procedure delivered by a preferred or contracted health
- 2 professional to a covered patient as a telemedicine medical service
- 3 or a telehealth service solely because the covered health care
- 4 service or procedure is not provided through an in-person
- 5 consultation; and
- 6 (B) subject to Subsection (c), limit, deny, or
- 7 reduce coverage for a covered health care service or procedure
- 8 <u>delivered as a telemedicine medical service or telehealth service</u>
- 9 based on the health professional's choice of platform for
- 10 delivering the service or procedure.
- 11 (b-1) Subsection (b) does not authorize a health benefit
- 12 plan to charge a separate deductible that applies only to a covered
- 13 <u>health care service or procedure delivered as a telemedicine</u>
- 14 medical service or telehealth service.
- 15 (d) A health benefit plan may not impose an annual or
- 16 <u>lifetime maximum on coverage for covered health care services or</u>
- 17 procedures delivered as telemedicine medical services or
- 18 telehealth services other than the annual or lifetime maximum, if
- 19 any, that applies in the aggregate to all items and services and
- 20 procedures covered under the plan.
- 21 SECTION 3. The changes to Section 1455.004, Insurance Code,
- 22 as amended by this Act, apply only to a health benefit plan
- 23 delivered, issued for delivery, or renewed on or after January 1,
- 24 2020. A health benefit plan delivered, issued for delivery, or
- 25 renewed before January 1, 2020, is governed by the law as it existed
- 26 immediately before the effective date of this Act, and that law is
- 27 continued in effect for that purpose.

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1 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
