## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to health benefit coverage provided by certain health benefit plans for telemedicine medical services and telehealth 3 services. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5 6 SECTION 1. Section 1455.001, Insurance Code, is amended by 7 adding Subdivision (2-a) to read as follows: (2-a) "Platform" means the technology, system, 8 software, application, modality, or other method through which a 9 health professional remotely interfaces with a patient when 10 providing a health care service or procedure as a telemedicine 11 12 medical service or telehealth service. SECTION 2. Section 1455.004, Insurance Code, is amended by 13 14 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsections (b-1) and (d) to read as follows: 15 16 (a) A health benefit plan: (1) must provide coverage for a covered health care 17 service or procedure delivered by a preferred or contracted health 18 professional to a covered patient as a telemedicine medical service 19 or telehealth service on the same basis and to the same extent that 20 the plan provides coverage for the service or procedure in an 21 22 in-person setting; and 23 (2) may not: 24 (A) exclude from coverage a covered health care

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1 service or procedure delivered by a preferred or contracted health 2 professional to a covered patient as a telemedicine medical service 3 or a telehealth service solely because the covered health care 4 service or procedure is not provided through an in-person 5 consultation; and

6 <u>(B) subject to Subsection (c), limit, deny, or</u> 7 <u>reduce coverage for a covered health care service or procedure</u> 8 <u>delivered as a telemedicine medical service or telehealth service</u> 9 <u>based on the health professional's choice of platform for</u> 10 <u>delivering the service or procedure</u>.

11 (b-1) Subsection (b) does not authorize a health benefit 12 plan to charge a separate deductible that applies only to a covered 13 health care service or procedure delivered as a telemedicine 14 medical service or telehealth service.

15 (d) A health benefit plan may not impose an annual or 16 lifetime maximum on coverage for covered health care services or 17 procedures delivered as telemedicine medical services or 18 telehealth services other than the annual or lifetime maximum, if 19 any, that applies in the aggregate to all items and services and 20 procedures covered under the plan.

SECTION 3. The changes to Section 1455.004, Insurance Code, as amended by this Act, apply only to a health benefit plan delivered, issued for delivery, or renewed on or after January 1, 2020. A health benefit plan delivered, issued for delivery, or renewed before January 1, 2020, is governed by the law as it existed immediately before the effective date of this Act, and that law is continued in effect for that purpose.

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1 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
