BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

4 SECTION 1. Section 51.601(a-1), Government Code, is amended

5 to read as follows:

- 6 (a-1) Notwithstanding Subsection (a), the clerk of each
- 7 court that has an official court reporter and that serves a county
- 8 with a population of 750,000 or more and located on the Texas-Mexico
- 9 border [that contains a municipality with a population of 500,000
- 10 or more] shall collect a court reporter service fee of \$30 as a
- 11 court cost in each civil case filed with the clerk to maintain a
- 12 court reporter who is available for assignment in the court.
- SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 14 to a case filed with the clerk of a court that has an official court
- 15 reporter on or after the effective date of this Act. A case filed
- 16 with the clerk of the court before the effective date of this Act is
- 17 governed by the law as it existed immediately before the effective
- 18 date of this Act, and the former law is continued in effect for that
- 19 purpose.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 24 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
