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- 2 relating to the establishment of a sickle cell task force.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Subtitle B, Title 2, Health and Safety Code, is
- 5 amended by adding Chapter 50 to read as follows:

6 CHAPTER 50. SICKLE CELL TASK FORCE

- 7 Sec. 50.001. ESTABLISHMENT OF TASK FORCE. The executive
- 8 commissioner, in collaboration with the members appointed to the
- 9 Newborn Screening Advisory Committee to represent the sickle cell
- 10 community, shall establish and maintain a task force to raise
- 11 awareness of sickle cell disease and sickle cell trait.
- 12 Sec. 50.002. DUTIES. (a) The task force shall study and
- 13 advise the department on implementing the recommendations made in
- 14 the 2018 Sickle Cell Advisory Committee Report published by the
- 15 Sickle Cell Advisory Committee or any other report the executive
- 16 commissioner determines is appropriate.
- 17 (b) The executive commissioner may assign tasks to the task
- 18 force to accomplish the purposes of this chapter.
- 19 Sec. 50.003. COMPOSITION OF TASK FORCE. The task force is
- 20 composed of the following members appointed by the executive
- 21 commissioner:
- 22 (1) two members from community-based organizations
- 23 with experience addressing the needs of individuals with sickle
- 24 cell disease;

- 1 (2) two physicians specializing in hematology;
- 2 (3) two members of the public, each of whom either has
- 3 sickle cell disease or is a parent of a person with sickle cell
- 4 disease or trait; and
- 5 (4) one representative of a health-related
- 6 institution.
- 7 Sec. 50.004. ADMINISTRATIVE SUPPORT. The executive
- 8 commissioner shall provide administrative support services at the
- 9 request of the task force.
- 10 <u>Sec. 50.005. PRESIDING OFFICER; MEETINGS. (a) The task</u>
- 11 force shall elect a presiding officer from among its membership.
- 12 (b) The task force shall meet at the call of the presiding
- 13 officer.
- 14 (c) The task force shall hold its first meeting not later
- 15 than December 1, 2019. This subsection expires September 1, 2021.
- 16 Sec. 50.006. COMPENSATION; REIMBURSEMENT; GIFTS, GRANTS,
- 17 AND DONATIONS. A task force member is not entitled to compensation
- 18 for service on the task force but is entitled to reimbursement for
- 19 actual and necessary expenses incurred in performing task force
- 20 duties. The task force may accept gifts, grants, and donations to
- 21 pay for those expenses.
- Sec. 50.007. ANNUAL REPORT. Not later than December 1 of
- 23 each year, the task force shall prepare and submit to the governor
- 24 and the legislature an annual written report that summarizes the
- 25 task force's work and includes any recommended actions or policy
- 26 changes endorsed by the task force.
- 27 SECTION 2. The sickle cell task force is not required to

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- 1 $\,$ comply with the reporting requirements under Section 50.007, Health
- 2 and Safety Code, as added by this Act, until December 1, 2020.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
