10	(b) Texas Girls in STEM Day shall be regularly observed by
11	appropriate ceremonies, activities, and programs in public
12	schools, public institutions of higher education, and other places
13	<u>to:</u>
14	(1) encourage girls in this state to consider career
15	fields in science, technology, engineering, and mathematics; and
16	(2) celebrate and honor the women of this state who
17	have excelled in those fields.
18	SECTION 2. Subchapter Z, Chapter 29, Education Code, is
19	amended by adding Section 29.925 to read as follows:

Girls in STEM Day, each school district may include throughout the

month of March appropriate instruction, activities, and programs to

encourage and celebrate women in career fields related to science,

technology, engineering, and mathematics. The instruction may

- 1 include programs that profile women in those fields and related
- 2 fields, including finance, information technology, data analytics,
- 3 cybersecurity, and health care cloud architecture.
- 4 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
