4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 11, Education Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 11.184 to read as follows:

- Sec. 11.184. EFFICIENCY AUDIT. (a) For purposes of this
- 8 <u>section</u>, "efficiency audit" means an investigation of the
- 9 operations of an independent school district to examine fiscal
- 10 <u>management and efficiency.</u>
- 11 (b) The board of trustees of an independent school district
- 12 <u>shall conduct an efficiency audit if:</u>
- 13 <u>(1) a petition requesting the board to conduct an</u> 14 efficiency audit for the district is:
- (A) signed not more than 90 days before the date
- 16 of submission by at least 10 percent of the voters who voted in the
- 17 most recent election of the board of trustees of the school
- 18 district; and
- 19 (B) submitted to and verified by the board of
- 20 trustees of the school district; and
- 21 (2) a majority of the voters voting in the election
- 22 under Subsection (c) approve the conducting of the efficiency
- 23 audit.
- 24 (c) If the board of trustees of an independent school

- 1 district determines the petition satisfies the requirements of
- 2 Subsection (b)(1)(A) and determines not to conduct an efficiency
- 3 audit, the board of trustees shall order an election to be held in
- 4 the district on the first uniform election date that allows
- 5 sufficient time to comply with other requirements of law.
- 6 (d) The ballot in an election to authorize an efficiency
- 7 audit under this section shall be printed to permit voting for or
- 8 against the proposition: "Requiring _____ Independent School
- 9 District to conduct an efficiency audit."
- 10 (e) An independent school district shall pay for an
- 11 efficiency audit under this section.
- 12 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 13 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 14 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 15 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 16 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
