- 8 (b) It is presumed that post-traumatic [Post-traumatic]
- 9 stress disorder suffered by a first responder is a compensable
- 10 injury under this subtitle unless it is shown by a preponderance of
- 11 the evidence [only if it is based on a diagnosis] that:
- 12 (1) the disorder is caused by an event occurring
- 13 outside [in] the course and scope of the first responder's
- 14 employment; or [and]
- 15 (2) no [the preponderance of the evidence indicates
- 16 that the] event that occurred in the course and scope of the first
- 17 <u>responder's employment</u> was a substantial contributing factor of the
- 18 disorder.
- 19 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 20 to a claim for workers' compensation benefits based on a
- 21 compensable injury that occurs on or after the effective date of
- 22 this Act. A claim based on a compensable injury that occurs before
- 23 that date is governed by the law as it existed on the date the
- 24 compensable injury occurred, and the former law is continued in

- 2 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
