15	Sec. 411.222. REQUIREMENTS FOR FIREARM LOAN AT SPORT
16	SHOOTING RANGE. A person may not loan a firearm to another person
17	for the purpose of shooting at a sport shooting range, as defined by
18	Section 250.001, Local Government Code, unless:
19	(1) the person is a licensed firearms dealer who
20	conducts a national instant criminal background check in the manner
21	required for the sale of a firearm by 18 U.S.C. Section 922 and
22	verifies that the person to whom the firearm is being loaned may

- 1 (A) the person loans the firearm to a licensed
- 2 firearms dealer, a peace officer, or a person licensed to carry a

- 6 firearms dealer who conducts a national instant criminal background

- 11 subchapter commits an offense. An offense under this section is a
- 12 Class C misdemeanor punishable by a fine not to exceed \$1,500.
