Sections 85.005(a) and (b), Family Code, are 4 5 amended to read as follows: To facilitate settlement, the parties to a proceeding 6 (a) may agree in writing to [the terms of] a protective order as 7 provided by <u>Sections</u> [Section] 85.021 and 85.022. An agreement 8 under this subsection is subject to the approval of the court. The 9 court may not approve an agreement that requires the applicant for 10 the protective order to do or refrain from doing an act under 11 Section 85.022. 12 (b) An [To facilitate settlement, a respondent may agree 13 14 writing to the terms of a protective order as provided by Sect 85.022, subject to the approval of the court. The court may not 15 16 approve an agreement that requires the applicant to do or refrain from doing an act under Section 85.022. The] agreed protective 17 order is enforceable civilly or criminally, regardless of whether 18 the court makes the findings required by Section 85.001. 19 SECTION 2. Section 85.006(a), Family Code, is amended to 20 21 read as follows: 22 Notwithstanding Rule 107, Texas Rules of Civil (a) 23 Procedure, a [A] court may render a protective order that is binding on a respondent who does not attend a hearing if:

Article 7A.01(a), Code of Criminal Procedure, is amended to read as follows: 6 7 (a) The following persons may file an application for a 8 protective order under this chapter without regard to the relationship between the applicant and the alleged offender: 9 (1) a person who is the victim of an offense under 10 Section 20A.02, 20A.03, 21.02, 21.11, 22.011, 22.021, [or] 42.072, 11 or 43.05, Penal Code; 12 any adult acting on behalf of a child or on behalf 13 (2) 14 of an adult ward who is the victim of an offense listed in Subdivision (1) [a person who is the victim of an offense under 15 Section 20A.02, 20A.03, or 43.05, Penal Code]; or 16 (3) [a parent or guardian acting on behalf of a person 17 younger than 17 years of age who is the victim of an offense listed 18 in Subdivision (1); 19 [(4) a parent or guardian acting on behalf of a person 20 younger than 18 years of age who is the victim of an offense listed 21 in Subdivision (2); or 22 $\left[\frac{(5)}{2}\right]$ a prosecuting attorney acting on behalf of a 23 24 person described by Subdivision (1) or [-7] (2) [-7], or (4). SECTION 4. Article 7A.07, Code of Criminal Procedure, is 25 amended by amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (c) to 26 read as follows: 27

(b) The following persons may file at any time an
 application with the court to rescind the protective order:

3 (1) a victim of an offense listed in Article
4 7A.01(a)(1) who is <u>18</u> [17] years of age or older;

5 (2) subject to Subsection (c), [or] a parent or 6 guardian acting on behalf of a victim <u>of an offense listed in</u> 7 <u>Article 7A.01(a)(1)</u> who is younger than <u>18</u> [17] years of age; or

8 (3) the person who filed the application for the 9 protective order.

10 (c) <u>A</u> [(2) <u>a victim of an offense listed in Article</u> 11 7A.01(a)(2) or a] parent or guardian <u>may not file an application to</u> 12 <u>rescind the protective order under Subsection (b)(2) if the parent</u> 13 <u>or guardian is the alleged offender subject to the protective order</u> 14 [<u>acting on behalf of a victim who is younger than 18 years of age</u>].

15 SECTION 5. Section 85.005, Family Code, as amended by this 16 Act, applies only to a protective order approved by the court on or 17 after the effective date of this Act.

18 SECTION 6. Section 85.006, Family Code, as amended by this 19 Act, applies only to a protective order for which the respondent 20 receives service on or after the effective date of this Act.

21 SECTION 7. Chapter 7A, Code of Criminal Procedure, as 22 amended by this Act, applies only to a protective order for which an 23 application is filed on or after the effective date of this Act.

24 SECTION 8. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
