## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to the exclusion of the operation of certain vehicles from
- 3 commercial driver's license requirements.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 522.004(a), Transportation Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) This chapter does not apply to:
- 8 (1) a vehicle that is controlled and operated by a
- 9 farmer and:
- 10 (A) used to transport agricultural products,
- 11 farm machinery, or farm supplies to or from a farm;
- 12 (B) used within 150 miles of the person's farm;
- 13 and

- 14 (C) not used in the operations of a common or
- 15 contract motor carrier;
- 16 (2) a fire-fighting or emergency vehicle necessary to
- 17 the preservation of life or property or the execution of emergency
- 18 governmental functions, whether operated by an employee of a
- 19 political subdivision or by a volunteer fire fighter;
- 20 (3) a military vehicle or a commercial motor vehicle,
- 21 when operated for military purposes by military personnel,
- 22 including:
- 23 (A) active duty military personnel, including
- 24 personnel serving in the United States Coast Guard; and

- 1 (B) members of the reserves and national guard on
- 2 active duty, including personnel on full-time national guard duty,
- 3 personnel engaged in part-time training, and national guard
- 4 military technicians;
- 5 (4) a recreational vehicle that is driven for personal
- 6 use;
- 7 (5) a vehicle that is owned, leased, or controlled by
- 8 an air carrier, as defined by Section 21.155, and that is driven or
- 9 operated exclusively by an employee of the air carrier only on the
- 10 premises of an airport, as defined by Section 22.001, on service
- 11 roads to which the public does not have access; [or]
- 12 (6) a vehicle used exclusively to transport seed
- 13 cotton modules or cotton burrs;
- 14 (7) a vehicle that is used for the purpose of
- 15 participating in equine activities or attending livestock shows, as
- 16 defined by Section 87.001, Civil Practice and Remedies Code; or
- 17 (8) a covered farm vehicle as defined by 49 C.F.R.
- 18 Section 390.5.
- 19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
