- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 61, Education Code, is

- 8 Sec. 61.06651. STUDY ON ELECTRONIC TEXTBOOK AND COURSE
- 9 MATERIAL COSTS. (a) In this section, "core curriculum" has the
- 10 meaning assigned by Section 61.821.
- 11 (b) The board shall conduct a study on methods to reduce the
- 12 cost of electronic textbooks and course materials required or
- 13 <u>recommended for core curriculum courses.</u>
- 14 (c) Not later than December 31, 2020, the board shall submit
- 15 to the governor, the lieutenant governor, the speaker of the house
- 16 of representatives, and the chair of each legislative standing
- 17 committee with jurisdiction over higher education a report on the
- 18 results of the study and any recommendations for legislative or
- 19 other action.
- 20 (d) This section expires September 1, 2021.
- 21 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 24 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
