7 with autism spectrum disorder to determine how those programs could 8 be replicated at or extended to postsecondary institutions.

9 <u>(d) Not later than December 1, 2021, the board shall submit</u> 10 <u>to the governor, the lieutenant governor, the speaker of the house</u> 11 <u>of representatives, and the commissioner of education a written</u> 12 <u>report that includes the study's findings and any recommendations</u> 13 <u>for legislative or other action.</u>

(e) This section expires January 1, 2022.

15 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 16 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 17 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 18 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 19 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
