- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 418, Government Code, is amended by 6 adding Section 418.054 to read as follows:
- 7 Section 418.054. TASK FORCE ON FAITH-BASED DISASTER
- 8 RESPONSE. (a) The task force on faith-based disaster response is
- 9 established to assist the division in fulfilling the division's
- 10 duties under Section 418.043, Government Code. The division shall
- 11 provide administrative support to the task force.
- 12 (b) The task force is composed of representatives of
- 13 <u>faith-based organizations active in disaster appointed by the chief</u>
- 14 of the division. The chief may appoint as many task force members
- 15 as are optimal to ensure effective representation of faith-based
- 16 organizations active in disaster response.

- 17 (c) The chief is designated as the interim presiding officer
- 18 for purposes of calling and conducting the initial meeting of the
- 19 task force. The task force shall at its initial meeting select a
- 20 presiding officer from among its members for the purpose of calling
- 21 and conducting meetings, and may select an assistant presiding
- 22 officer and a secretary from among its members. A member of the
- 23 task force may not receive compensation or reimbursement for
- 24 service on the task force.

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- 1 (d) After its initial meeting, the task force shall meet at
- 2 least twice each year at a time and place determined by the
- 3 presiding officer. The task force may meet at other times the task
- 4 force considers appropriate. The presiding officer may call a
- 5 meeting on the officer's own motion. The task force may meet by
- 6 teleconference.
- 7 <u>(e) The task force shall:</u>
- 8 <u>(1) develop and implement a plan for improving data</u>
- 9 collection regarding faith-based organizations that participate in
- 10 disaster relief;
- 11 (2) develop best practices for communicating,
- 12 cooperating, and collaborating with faith-based organizations to
- 13 strengthen disaster response in this state;
- 14 (3) identify and address inefficiencies in disaster
- 15 relief provided by the state and faith-based organizations; and
- 16 (4) identify and address gaps in state services that
- 17 faith-based organizations could fill.
- (f) The task force shall prepare a report and may include
- 19 recommendations relating to legislation or administrative actions
- 20 necessary to address an issue identified by the task force related
- 21 to the participation of faith-based organizations in disaster
- 22 relief. The task force shall present the report to the Legislature
- 23 and Governor not later than December 1, 2020.
- 24 (g) The task force may solicit, accept, and administer
- 25 gifts, grants, and donations from any public or private source.
- 26 (h) This section expires September 1, 2021.
- SECTION 2. Not later than October 1, 2019, the chief of the

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- 1 Texas Division of Emergency Management shall appoint members to the
- 2 task force on faith-based disaster response in accordance with
- 3 Section 416.054, Government Code, as added by this Act.
- 4 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
