1-21 relating to the jurisdiction of a county court at law in Tarrant
 1-22 County.

1-23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-24 SECTION 1. Section 25.2222(a), Government Code, is amended
 1-25 to read as follows:

1-26 (a) A county court at law in Tarrant County has jurisdiction
 1-27 over all causes and proceedings, civil [~~matters~~] and criminal
 1-28 [~~causes~~], original and appellate, prescribed by law for county
 1-29 courts. [~~The County Court at Law No. 1 of Tarrant County also has~~
 1-30 ~~jurisdiction over all criminal matters and causes, original and~~
 1-31 ~~appellate, prescribed by law for county courts. The County Courts~~
 1-32 ~~at Law Nos. 2 and 3 of Tarrant County do not have criminal~~
 1-33 ~~jurisdiction.~~] Notwithstanding any other provision, a county court
 1-34 at law in Tarrant County has jurisdiction on any appeal from a
 1-35 municipal court of record in Tarrant County that is not an appeal of
 1-36 a criminal law case or proceeding.

1-37 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
