## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to a study and report regarding school district size and 3 school district cost and academic effectiveness.

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. (a) The commissioner of education shall conduct
- 6 a study regarding the relationship between school district size and
- 7 school district cost and academic effectiveness. In conducting the
- 8 study, the commissioner shall consider factors affecting the
- 9 operation of school districts, including:
- 10 (1) organization and management;
- 11 (2) financial soundness;
- 12 (3) transportation and other general services;
- 13 (4) parent accessibility to school district
- 14 administration; and
- 15 (5) campus feeder patterns.
- 16 (b) On the request of the commissioner of education,
- 17 regional education service centers and the State Board of Education
- 18 shall assist the commissioner in conducting the study under this
- 19 section.

- 20 (c) Not later than December 31, 2020, the commissioner of
- 21 education shall submit to the governor, the lieutenant governor,
- 22 the speaker of the house of representatives, and each legislative
- 23 standing committee with primary jurisdiction over public education
- 24 a report that includes:

- 1 (1) the results of the study conducted under this
- 2 section, including any determinations made with regard to an
- 3 optimal school district size that would promote efficient operation
- 4 and attainment of state educational goals; and
- 5 (2) recommendations for legislative or other action.
- 6 SECTION 2. This Act expires January 1, 2021.
- 7 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 8 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 9 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 10 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 11 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
