- 7 SECTION 1. Subchapter Z, Chapter 51, Education Code, is
- 8 amended by adding Section 51.9362 to read as follows:
- 9 Sec. 51.9362. DRUG AND ALCOHOL AWARENESS TRAINING FOR
- 10 RESIDENTIAL ADVISORS AND STUDENT ORGANIZATION OFFICERS. (a) In
- 11 this section:
- 12 (1) "Public or private institution of higher
- 13 education" includes an "institution of higher education" and a
- 14 "private or independent institution of higher education," as those
- 15 terms are defined by Section 61.003.
- 16 (2) "Residential advisor" means a student who is
- 17 employed by a public or private institution of higher education to
- 18 serve in an advisory capacity for students living in a residential
- 19 facility.
- 20 (3) "Residential facility" means a residence used
- 21 exclusively for housing or boarding students or faculty of a public
- 22 or private institution of higher education.
- 23 (4) "Student organization" includes any organization
- 24 that is composed mostly of students enrolled at a public or private

- 1 institution of higher education and that:
- 2 (A) is registered with the institution;
- 3 (B) receives student organization resource fee
- 4 revenues or other funding from the institution; or
- 5 (C) is otherwise recognized as a student
- 6 organization by the institution.
- 7 (b) A public or private institution of higher education that
- 8 <u>imposes</u> any mandatory training requirements on residential
- 9 advisors or officers of student organizations must ensure that drug
- 10 and alcohol overdose awareness and appropriate response training is
- 11 <u>included with that training.</u>
- 12 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with training
- 13 required for the 2019-2020 academic year.
- 14 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 15 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 16 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 17 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 18 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
