5	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 31, Election Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 31.014 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 31.014. STUDY ON IMPLEMENTATION OF VOTER
8	IDENTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS. (a) The secretary of state shall
9	conduct a study on the implementation of the changes in law made by
10	Chapter 123 (S.B. 14), Acts of the 82nd Legislature, Regular
11	Session, 2011, and Chapter 410 (S.B. 5), Acts of the 85th
12	Legislature, Regular Session, 2017, including:
13	(1) the costs of implementation;
14	(2) additional requirements for election workers to
15	accept a voter;
16	(3) the amount of time needed to accept a voter at the
17	polling place; and
18	(4) training, if any, provided to election workers at
19	the county and precinct levels.
20	(b) Not later than January 1, 2021, the secretary of state
21	shall report the study's findings to the committees of each house of
22	the legislature with jurisdiction over elections.
23	(c) This section expires September 1, 2021.
24	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
