AN ACT

- 2 relating to grants awarded to nonprofit food banks for disaster
- 3 response.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 418, Government Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 418.026 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 418.026. DISASTER GRANTS FOR NONPROFIT FOOD BANKS.
- 8 (a) In this section, "nonprofit food bank" means a nonprofit
- 9 organization that solicits, warehouses, and redistributes edible
- 10 food to agencies that feed needy families and individuals.
- 11 (b) The office of the governor shall establish a program to
- 12 provide grants to nonprofit food banks in this state to build the
- 13 capacity of nonprofit food banks to respond to disasters.
- 14 (c) Grant money awarded under this section may be used only
- 15 to reimburse a nonprofit food bank for all or part of the costs
- 16 incurred by the nonprofit food bank as a result of:
- (1) maintaining an inventory of emergency food boxes
- 18 <u>in preparation for a disaster;</u>
- 19 (2) purchasing, storing, and transporting food for
- 20 <u>distribution during a disaster; and</u>
- 21 (3) purchasing capital equipment necessary to operate
- 22 through a disaster, including back-up generators, mobile food
- 23 pantries, trucks, meal preparation units, forklifts, technology,
- 24 and other equipment.

- 1 (d) The office of the governor shall establish procedures to
- 2 administer the grant program, including a procedure for the
- 3 submission of a proposal and a procedure to be used by the office to
- 4 evaluate a proposal.
- 5 (e) The office of the governor shall enter into a contract
- 6 that includes performance requirements with each grant recipient.
- 7 The office shall monitor and enforce the terms of the contract. The
- 8 contract must authorize the office to recoup grant money from a
- 9 grant recipient for failure of the grant recipient to comply with
- 10 the terms of the contract.
- 11 (f) The office of the governor may solicit and accept gifts,
- 12 grants, and donations from any source for the purpose of awarding
- 13 grants under this section.
- 14 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
